Immanuel: God is with us. This is perhaps the most astounding statement in Scripture. Not that God exists. Not even that God loves. But that the God who is and who loves, is near, with us, interested in our lives and accompanying our days.

This is astounding: that the God who speaks universes into being and who sustains every living thing by his power, offers himself to us as companion, parent and ever-present friend. And so, isn't it shocking that we seem so capable of losing the reality of his presence in the mundane business of daily life?! As we lead up to Advent meditate on the closeness of Immanuel. Learn to visualise the reality of his presence.

"As I work, a Loved Presence over my shoulder: as I drive, a Loved Passenger beside me. In my reading, cooking, studying: whilst teaching, nursing, accounting: in the maelstrom of the supermarket, or waiting for the bus or rain - ever the loving sense of a Presence, always that longing for my Creator".

Use the news as a source of prayer pointers. Pray for:

- Kenya, following the recent re-run of the election. The country is divided and there are fears of another cycle of post-election violence. When that happened 10 years ago, more than 1,100 people died.
- Christians in Nepal following the recent law criminalising evangelism and conversion.
- a peaceful resolution to the tensions within Spain.
- children being used as drugrunners by Mexico's drug cartels.

Personal Renewal

Try this in November. Memorise this short prayer:

You Lord, are in this place Your Presence fills it Your Presence is love.

You Lord, are in my heart Your Presence fills it Your Presence is love.

As you move through each day, train yourself to pause and say these words. As you go for coffee with a friend; as you enter the business meeting; as you return home; as you walk the dog or settle the children.

Pray into the reality of God with you, God in you.
