Title: Advent 1 - When the King Comes: New Creation

Introduction:

Advent is a time for remembering both the first and second comings of Jesus. The second coming should be a cause for hope and the means of encouraging us to stand firm as Christians. (Remember, the joyful future set before Jesus, enabled him to endure the cross – Hebrews 12:2).

Review:

Jesus spoke about his second advent numerous times (e.g. Matt 24:30). We can therefore be sure that it will happen and can expect it to be a time for "the removal of the faithless" (Matthew 24:36-44), "the reward of the faithful" (Rev. 22:12, 21:7) and "the renewal of all things" (Matthew 19:28) (these are the main points from the talk).

Revelation 21:1-8

Reflect

Love for Neighbour & World: In what ways do these themes shape our responses and relationships with those we meet who may not know God personally?
