

Sunday Evenings at TBC


Sunday evenings at TBC seek to satisfy the needs of a growing disciple in a number of ways.



DIGGING DEEPER
more from your Bible

May 22nd - Adam & Eve and the Fall
Rev Dr Ernest Lucas will be returning to follow up his earlier talk on Genesis and Science. Much Christian theology rests on a belief that the world has somehow 'fallen' from God's initial intentions. But what was it that Adam and Eve fell from - and who were Adam and Eve anyway?!

June 26th - Spirit in the Church & World
The Christian life is a 'life in the Spirit'. This session will explore the central place of the Holy Spirit in the life of a follower of Jesus, and also ask the question, is the Spirit only at work in the church or can we discover his work in the world too? This session will be led by David Lawrence.

July 24th - Metaphors of Grace
The writers of Scripture often use graphic picture language to communicate the extraordinary depth and variety of God's goodness toward us. We hope to select some examples to help us see and understand God's grace in 3-D.

This session will be led by Rev Dr Gordon Molyneux. Gordon was born and grew up in central Congo, a country to which he returned to serve in theological education for over 21 years. He and his wife Christine subsequently were on the staff of All Nations Christian College, and more recently served on the home end of Serving in Mission. They are now retired and live in Yate.
