Worrying does not change anything or achieve anything, but it is difficult not to worry!

Often we go over our concerns in our minds again and again, exploring all the 'what ifs', getting tense and focusing inward. But Jesus said 'Do not worry' and Paul said 'Do not be anxious'. God knows our needs. It is hard to do. but we need to let go of our worries and learn to trust God Worries are not easily solved, nor do all our problems disappear once they have been prayed for. But what we can seek to do through prayer is bring our worries to a Father who loves us and hand them over to Him so we can take the focus off ourselves.
