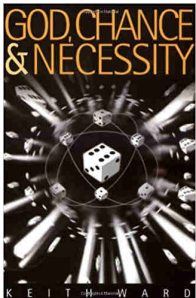

In the beginning was the Word,



That there exists any matter/energy which is governed by any laws of physics is... an extraordinary coincidence, since there might very well have been no matter at all, or there might have been no laws of physics, or there might have been something to which laws did not apply, or the laws might have ceased to exist soon after coming into being. That is, events might not have continued behaving in the regular and predictable ways that could be described by such laws. The fact that there are laws which continue to operate on matter/energy in regular and predictable ways is a rather surprising fact, which might well have been otherwise. **The whole set-up is not quite as simple as it may seem.**

"The Greek word *kyrios* thus came to be reserved [in Jewish thought] for God. Jews of the first century refused to address the emperor as 'Lord' (*kyrios*), clearly on account of their belief that this term was appropriate to God alone. The use of the term to refer to Jesus in the New Testament thus draws on this rich tradition of association, **implying a high degree of identity between Jesus and God**"

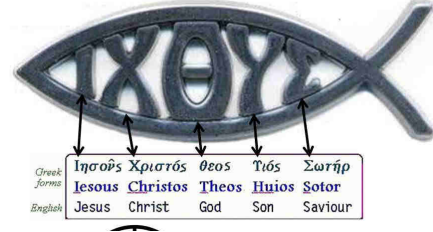

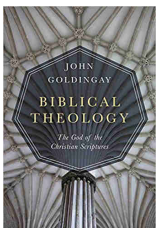

We, then, following the holy Fathers, all with one consent, teach men to confess one and the same Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, the same **perfect in Godhead** and also **perfect in manhood; truly God and truly man**, of a reasonable soul and body; consubstantial with us according to the manhood; in all things like unto us, without sin; begotten before all ages of the Father according to the Godhead, and in these latter days, for us and for our salvation, born of the virgin Mary, the mother of God, according to the manhood; one and the same Christ, Son, Lord, Only-begotten, **to be acknowledged in two natures, inconfusedly, unchangeably, indivisibly, inseparably; the distinction of natures being by no means taken away by the union, but rather the property of each nature being preserved**, and concurring in one Person and one Subsistence, not parted or divided into two persons, but one and the same Son, and only begotten, God the Word, the Lord Jesus Christ, as the prophets from the beginning have declared concerning him, and the Lord Jesus Christ himself taught us, and the Creed of the holy Fathers has handed down to us.

Incarnation

If the church is to be in a position to offer all people the mystery of salvation and the life brought by God, then it must implant itself among all these groups in the same way that Christ by his incarnation committed himself to the particular social and cultural circumstances of the men among whom he lived.

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
