Then the Lord said to Moses, "I will rain down bread from heaven for you. The people are to go out each day and gather enough for that day... " (Exodus 16)


The provision of daily manna in the wilderness, is an image of God's provision for us in Jesus, "the bread who is come down from heaven".

TBC's Frontline Missionaries - Education & Childcare

Hi, I'm Carol, married to Dave, and I've been part of the TBC family for 15 years, since we moved to Thornbury from Cheshire with our two children. For the past seven years, I have worked in a local primary school as a Special Needs Teaching Assistant.

As a Teaching Assistant, I am often the first point of contact for a child who may be struggling with school, for whatever reason, so some of my time is spent as a listening ear, or offering emotional support, as well as providing classroom support for the children I work closely with. Whilst I love my job because I can be a positive role model and show love and care, it can be exhausting at times!

I am fortunate to work with some Christians, and it's wonderful to be able to support one another.
