The TBC Prayer Chain is active throughout this time of need in our world. Please would you join us? Details are on the website.


Pray For:

My name is Richard and I'm married to Nicki with two sons, Jamie & Will at university. I fell into sales 20+ years ago - a happy accident following a job change from banking - and I immediately felt at home in that environment.

If someone asks me what my faith is about it's: "no guilt in life, no fear in death, this is the power of Christ in me". This speaks to me of two great sources of hope that Jesus offers, not just life after death, but meaning and purpose right now.

Jesus' parable told in Matthew 13, Mark 4 and Luke 8. Often called the "Parable of the Sower" or the "Story of the Seeds". It's actually all about the ground.
