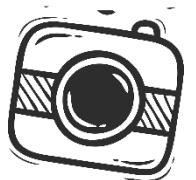


## Story highlight

 **GO FOR A PICNIC!** – The boy with the fish was happy to share all that he had with Jesus. Help your family to prepare a picnic to share with them. Why not ask your friends to do the same and you can picnic together?!

 **FISH MOBILE** – The boy gave his fish to Jesus as his way of sharing with others! Can you make a mobile to put up in your window or your garden to catch the light and spread a little light to others?

 **THE GROWING CHALLENGE** – What seeds can you plant to create your own food? You can grow something quick and easy like cress or you could see what you can grow from seeds you cut out of salad veg or fruit!

 **THE GUMMY BEAR CHALLENGE** – Jesus was able to share just 5 little loaves of bread around 5000 people and they all had enough to eat! See if you can make a little gummy bear into a huge one!!

 **THE FISHING GAME** – Take a straw and use it to suck up paper fish or cereal or sweets and see how many you can suck up in 30 seconds! Or you can have a go at racing a family member and see who collects the most "fish"!
