

Making a Difference Just Where You Are

The great divide is the all-too-common belief that some parts of life are really sacred and important to God (prayer, Sunday services, volunteering for church activities) - but that others are 'secular' and largely irrelevant to God.

The Great Divide

This false belief limits the *church's mission* to activities in or near the building (or somewhere far, far away);

limits the mission's messengers to church staff and missionaries; limits mission's time to what we can fit in at evenings and weekends and limits the mission's message, suggesting that God is only interested in 'spiritual 'things.

At TBC we believe that God is interested and active in every part of our lives. God's mission is outworked through each of us, wherever we are on our daily 'frontlines'. The work that we do, the way do that work, the difference our work makes, the impact we have on colleagues and the outcomes of our work are all opportunities for 'God's will to be done on earth as in heaven'.

Here's some questions for prayerful reflection:

- How have I seen God's hand at work in my daily life?
- What do I sense God might be doing through me on my frontline?
- How does my faith change the way I view my frontline?
- What does it mean for me to pray 'Your Kingdom Come' on my frontline?
