And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.



- 3 There was a man named Nicodemus, a Jewish religious leader who was a Pharisee. 2 After dark one evening, he came to speak with Jesus. "Rabbi," he said, "we all know that God has sent you to teach us. Your miraculous signs are evidence that God is with you."
- **3** Jesus replied, "I tell you the truth, unless you are born again, you cannot see the Kingdom of God."
- 4 "What do you mean?" exclaimed Nicodemus. "How can an old man go back into his mother's womb and be born again?"
- **5** Jesus replied, "I assure you, no one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born of water **and the Spirit**. **6** Humans can reproduce only human life, but the **Holy Spirit gives birth to spiritual life**.
- 7 So don't be surprised when I say, 'You must be born again.'




the effect of NEW LIFE: Holiness

16 So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves. 17 The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us desires that are the opposite of what the sinful nature desires. These two forces are constantly fighting each other, so you are not free to carry out your good intentions......

24 Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed the passions and desires of their sinful nature to his cross and crucified them there.

the strength for NEW LIFE: empowered by God




