The LifeSTREAM question

• In the second sentence the tree's deep roots are mentioned. Roots are the means of a tree being fed. How are you rooted in God, and how do you 'feed' or nourish your Christian life? Has this changed over the years?

The LifeSHAPE question

 How would you describe the 'shape' of a Christian's life, using these verses? What 'fruit' might you see? What is your experience of this verse?

Your Story

 Using LlfeWORK's three themes (see illustration opposite, and introduction top right), how would you help a new Christian establish their lives as a follower of Jesus?

* These questions are a guide only. Do not feel you have to cover them all. Do feel free to allow the conversation to develop in other directions, if it seems fruitful (and stays on the subject!). Do pray for one another.

By paying attention to what God gives to us (our LifeSOURCE), to the shape of our daily lives (our LifeSHAPE) and to our regular encounters with God (our LifeSTREAMS) we stay rooted in God and become confident and effective for Jesus in our daily lives.
