### Your Story

- What does 'knowing God' mean to you?

- What difference has God's presence made to your daily life in the past week?
- What has been your recent experience of knowing God's presence, or feeling his absence?

Read the passage on the opposite page.

Take a slow look at the LIFEText (opposite) and consider these questions:

- What do we see about the *character* of God?
- What do we see about the *work* of God?
- What do we see about the *nature of our relationship* with God?
- Which verses connect with your recent experience of God?
- Are there any verses that seem *not* to connect with your experience? Why is that?
- What does it mean to you, to 'call on God' (v18)?
- What does it mean to you to 'fear' God (v19)?
