


TBC's Frontline Missionaries - Health Care

I am Helen Harrison, and one of my 'frontlines' is as a community-based carer for elderly and vulnerable adults.

I've had this role since the first lockdown in 2020, and I love it! As care-workers, we provide support for elderly and vulnerable adults who live at home but need extra input. Some live with family members, others live alone, and we might be their only visitor that day. We help with feeding, personal care, medications, and being a friendly and supportive presence. Mostly we work alone as single carers although sometimes we work as doubles.

I try to show my faith by caring for each client as a loved child of God. I hold in my head 'What would Jesus do or say'





- For the care-workers –for compassion as they care for their clients, for wisdom when making important decisions on how to deal with all situations, and for safety on the roads as they drive between clients.
- For the clients and their families for grace and tolerance towards the careworkers who are doing their best within a very under-funded and underresourced care system.



TBC Mission Projects

Alpha is a relaxed introduction to the Christian faith, particularly for those with little or no church background.

Based around videos, a meal and the opportunity to discuss together without any compulsion or pressure, no question is off limits, and most people find they quickly enjoy meeting together.

Discussion explores topics like:

'Why did Jesus die?'

'How can I have faith?'

'How does God guide us?'

And 'Why and How do I pray?' To see how they affect how we live.

We will be looking to start an Alpha course in March, so if you've never been or have someone you'd like to bring, we'd love to have you.

Local/UK Partners

Oasis house is a TBC mission initiative which provides a home for men who have experienced some form of homelessness. We currently house five men. The project aim is to create a community family space where men from all walks of life can find healing and restoration, this is facilitated through personal support plans and one-to-one mentoring. We hold a number of meetings throughout the week, Monday evening house meeting, which includes communion and Thursday Friendship Meal which is also open to the wider community. We have also just started the bible course on Wednesday nights which generates some very interesting questions concerning the meaning life and God.
