

TBC's Frontline Missionaries – Education & Childcare

Hi, my name is Joanna Ebbs. I am married to Richard and we have 6 wonderful children. They are Billy, Chloe, Daisy, Micah, Matthew and Florence. aged between 9 and 24.

I have lived in Thornbury all my life and have been involved with Thornbury Baptist Church since becoming a Christian at 16.

I have volunteered in different areas of church including crèche, Sunday school and Two by Two. I now help with stewarding and the coffee rota and Richard leads worship and helps on the sound desk.

I work three days a week in a local preschool and volunteer one morning a week at the clothing store in the Methodist church hall.



I work in a lovely local village preschool with 2-4 year olds in a warm, caring, safe environment that enables the children to learn and discover through play.

As a Christian I feel an important part of my work is showing God's love to the children through how I interact with them and care for them. Also to build good relationships with the parents/grandparents that trust us with their precious children/grandchildren.

Local/UK Partners – Ukraine

Hello everyone, my name is Alex Lorhov, and I'm from Ukraine. I want to share our country's prayer needs. The Russia-Ukraine war is in an intense phase, causing numerous military deaths and injuries. Many wounded soldiers are seeking financial help for treatment. Civilians lack money for food and medication due to rising costs and falling wages. Finding work is difficult with many factories destroyed by rockets. Rent prices surge due to returning refugees from Russian-conquered areas. Survival is tough for pensioners due to very low pensions for most.

There's no safe place in Ukraine as rockets or drones can strike anywhere. Almost daily, innocent lives are lost. Many churches invite the needy for services and distribute food afterward. Let's pray for God to touch their hearts with the Holy Spirit.

Occupied areas also face challenges. Russian soldiers take some prayer houses and ban gatherings. In other churches, young Christian families leave conflict zones, leaving mainly the elderly.
