Discussion Questions

- In what ways do we “Ask, Seek, and Knock” for God’s provision in our lives, as described in Matt 7:7-8?
- How do we demonstrate Jesus’ instruction to pursue God through prayer in our everyday lives?
- What comfort do you find in knowing that your heavenly Father hears us according to His will and desires to respond to our prayers (1 John 5:14)?
- What do you think God’s will is, and how can we keep this in mind when we pray?
- God’s will for us is to know wholeness in body, soul, and spirit (1 Thess 5:23). In what areas of our lives would we like to see more of the Holy Spirit’s activity?
- In Matthew 6:25-30, Jesus calls us to trust God for our material needs. What does this look like in our own lives? Are there any areas where we need to surrender to God’s care?
- In Matthew 6:33, Jesus tells us to seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to us. What does this look like in practice, and how can we apply this command on a daily basis?
